Job: Install Circuit for Copy Machine

1. Run (1) 20 amp 110 volt dedicated line from electrical room, through warehouse, then through T-Bar ceiling to new copy machine location
2. Install electrical power pole in corner of cubicle for copy machine
3. Install (1) 20 amp 110 volt outlet on power pole
4. Use existing breaker in existing sub panel
5. Work to be done at prevailing wage

All of the above work to be completed in a substantial workmanlike manner according to standard practices for the sum of Three Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars \$3,250.00

Payments to be made Upon Completion

Rough or draw payments are required before finish or any progress can be started.

The entire amount of the contract to be paid within Thirty (30) days after completion.

This proposal is valid for Thirty (30) days from date written above.



NOTICE TO OWNER

Contractors are required by law to be licensed and regulated by the Contractor's State License Board. Any questions concerning a contractor may be referred to the registrar of the board whose address is: Contractor's State License Board, 1020 N. Street, Sacramento, California 95814

"Under the Mechanic's Lien Law, any contractor, subcontractor, laborer, material man or other person who helps to improve your property and is not paid for his labor, services or material, has the right to enforce his claim against your property.

"Under the law, you may protect yourself against such claims by filing, before commencing such work or improvement, an original contract for the

work or improvement of a modification thereof, in the office of the county recorder of the county where the property is situated and requiring that a contractor's payment bond be recorded in such office. Said bond shall be in the amount not less than fifty percent(50%) of the contract price and shall, in addition to any conditions for the performance of the contract, be conditioned for the payment of full of the claims of all persons furnishing labor, services, equipment or materials for the work described in said contract.
