

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## Cal-HOSA SLC 2022 Covid-19 Safety Plan

### Health and Safety

Cal-HOSA is happy to return to an in-person State Leadership Conference (SLC) in 2022. As part of Cal-HOSA's plans to host a safe event, please follow the listed SLC safety requirements and recommendations below to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

The Long Beach Convention Center, under the direction of the City of Long Beach Health and Human Services Department as well as following guidance from the California Department of Public Health requires the use of face masks in all indoor public settings, venues, public gatherings, and public and private businesses, regardless of COVID-19 vaccination status.

**Cal-HOSA will follow the most current guidelines at the time of the SLC.**

### Face Masks

Mask wearing is required, regardless of vaccination status, in all indoor spaces at the 2022 SLC. Masks must be worn over the mouth and nose by everyone except when **actively eating or drinking while stationary**. Attendees actively competing, performing, or presenting in an activity that requires public speaking, or singing **must wear masks at all times** while directly participating in that activity.

*Masks are acceptable to wear with Official Dress.*

### Vaccination & Wearing of Masks

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) says the best way to prevent the spread of COVID-19 is to get the vaccine, which is free and widely available for all persons 5 years of age and older.

### Full Vaccination Status or Pre-Entry Negative Tests

The Long Beach Convention Center, under the direction of the City of Long Beach Health & Human Services Department, requires proof of **full vaccination or pre-entry negative tests** for all indoor events greater than 1,000 attendees (including staff to support the event).

**Full Vaccination Verification:** Acceptable forms of proof of full COVID-19 vaccination status include (a) photo identification of the attendee AND (b) any of the following - a vaccination card, a photo of the vaccination card as a separate document, a photo of the attendee's vaccine card stored on a phone or electronic device, a digital version of the vaccination card (e.g., QR Code), or documentation of the person's full vaccination against COVID-19 from a healthcare provider. The vaccination card must include the name of the person vaccinated, the type of COVID-19 vaccine provided, and the date of the last dose administered.

*For purposes of this Order, an individual is considered "fully vaccinated" against COVID-19 two weeks or more after they have received the second dose in a 2-dose series (e.g., Pfizer-BioNtech or Moderna) or two weeks or more after they have received a single-dose vaccine (e.g., Johnson and Johnson [J&J]/Janssen).*

### Pre-Admission Testing for COVID-19:

Pre-entry negative testing must be conducted within 72 hours before the event start time. Both PCR and antigen tests are acceptable forms of pre-entry negative testing. The results of the test must be available prior to entry into the event or venue. Acceptable forms of proof of a negative COVID-19 test result include (a) photo identification of the attendee AND (b) either of the following – a

printed document from the test provider or laboratory OR an email or text message displayed on a phone from the test provider or laboratory. The test result should include the person's name, type of test performed, negative test result, and the date of the test must be within the last 72 hours. This Section shall apply to attendees two (2) years of age and older.

### Travel Guidelines

The CDC has guidelines for travel in the United States during the COVID-19 pandemic.

If you are fully vaccinated, self-monitor for symptoms, continue to wear a mask and take other precautions during travel.

If you are not vaccinated, get a COVID-19 test 1-3 days before travel, self-monitor for symptoms, continue to wear a mask and take other precautions.

It is recommended you also get tested 3-5 days after travel and self-quarantine for 7-10 days.

### If you have symptoms of COVID-19:

- If you develop symptoms of COVID-19 less than 10 days before the SLC, do not attend the event.
- **If a student develops symptoms of COVID-19** while attending the Cal-HOSA SLC event the student must contact their advisor immediately, and the advisor must initiate their district COVID 19 policies. The advisor will notify Cal-HOSA administrative staff with an update of the student status and their immediate plan of action.
- **If an advisor develops symptoms of COVID-19** while attending the Cal-HOSA SLC event the advisor must immediately initiate their district COVID-19 policies and notify Cal-HOSA administrative staff with an update and their immediate plan of action.

### Convention Center Protocols

Convention Event Staff at the 2022 SLC will follow many protocols to promote a safe event. *See attached document [Covid Compliance Checklist LBCC](#) for specific protocols and requirements.*

### Area/Hotel Protocols

Long Beach Departments of Public Health mandate requires all individuals to wear face coverings when entering any public establishment regardless of vaccination status, and practice physical distancing in all public areas (6 feet).

## Long Beach Visual Guidance Verifying Proof of COVID-19 Vaccination



### How to verify if a person is fully vaccinated

- ✓ Check to see if the name on the vaccination record matches a photo ID, AND
- ✓ Check proof of COVID-19 vaccination for vaccination type and date(s) (a and b on image)
  - If Johnson & Johnson (J&J), verify single dose with date 14 days prior to today
  - If Pfizer or Moderna, verify two doses with dates, the most recent being 14 days prior to today

### Acceptable proof of COVID-19 vaccination

#### A. Vaccine Record Card or Health Record



- CDC COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card (White Card)
- World Health Organization (WHO) Vaccine Record Card (Yellow Card)
- Documentation of vaccination from the healthcare provider or entity that provided the COVID-19 vaccines
- California Immunization Registry (CAIR2) Vaccination Record

The person can show the card, a photo of the card as a separate document, or a photo of the card stored on a phone or electronic device.

#### B. Digital Vaccination Record



Issued by:

- California Department of Public Health (CDPH)\* (free)
- An approved company (e.g. Healthvana and Carbon Health) (free)

\* Businesses can download the free SMART Health Card verifier app to read the QR code ([thecommonsproject.org/smart-health-card-verifier](https://thecommonsproject.org/smart-health-card-verifier)). Scan the code and confirm there's a green "Verified" indicator at the top of the screen and the required information ✓ is shown.



For visitors from other state or countries, ask for similar vaccination documentation issued by their local government.

A person who was vaccinated outside the US is considered to be fully vaccinated 14 days after they finish a series of a COVID-19 vaccine that vaccine is listed for emergency use by the World Health Organization (WHO) – currently AstraZeneca-Oxford (e.g., Covishield, Vaxzevria), Sinopharm, and Sinovac.
