

PROPOSAL
Revised 3/7/2022

PROJECT: Greenhouse repairs

SCOPE OF WORK: On an existing Conley Senior Teaching greenhouse measuring 30' wide by 60' long by 8' at the eave, we propose to provide labor and materials to perform the following repairs:

1. We will remove one heater and flue from the existing heater mount, leaving the mount in place for re-use. We will provide and install one new Modine PDP 150 heater and a new flue pipe.
2. We will demo the existing 30' long by 3' tall Kool-cel system, including the pad stringers, four shutters and the wall glazing below the Kool-cel pad. We will clean and paint the columns.
3. We will provide and install a new lower wall girt and a new Kool-cel system measuring 6" thick, 48" tall and approximately 28' long, including a new steel pad mount.
4. We will provide and install a new pad vent measuring 24' long by 4' tall. We will glaze the pad vent and the below-vent area with new 8mm twinwall polycarbonate (PC-8)
5. We will provide and install one new Ridder pad vent motor.

If the electrical is fully operational we will set the limit switch for the new pad vent motor. If the electrical is not fully operational before the Ag-Con crew has left the site, we will set the limit switch to a preliminary setting and final limit switch adjustment will need to be made by electrical personnel (if Ag-Con needs to return to the job site to set the limit switch, a service call fee may be charged).

This bid does not include plumbing or electrical work, and does not include any unspecified repairs or renovations to the existing structure or equipment and does not include replacement of the heater mount. This bid does not include procurement or provision of any drawings or permits.

This bid does not include receiving, unloading or storage of materials, jobsite security, debris disposal, provision of sanitary facilities, provision of any bid or performance bond, provision of insurance beyond our customary limits, or third-party administration. Ag-Con is not responsible for compliance to any additional codes (government, county, entity, etc.) and is not responsible for scheduling, paying

for, or complying with the results of special inspections, beyond standard agricultural codes and practices.

Important notice: This pad vent needs to be covered by a protective fence, to prevent injury to students. Provision or installation of the protective fence is not included in this bid.
