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EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION

Funding

- ▶ **State Assembly Bill 86** provided funding for Adult Education programs
- ▶ Funding is provided to Consortiums made up of community colleges and K-12 School Districts that fall within the geographical “jurisdictions” of each community college district.

Division of Funds

- ▶ The Stanislaus/Mother Lode Consortium was allocated **\$2,677,536** in an Adult Education Block Grant for the 2015-16 fiscal year
- ▶ 3 years of same or similar funding amounts are expected from the State
- ▶ Each Consortium partner will submit a proposal for the Adult Education programs they wish to offer and the amount of funds requested to provide those programs.
- ▶ Each partner has 1 vote on the Consortium

PJUSD Proposal

- ▶ Expansion of English as a Second Language classes from the current 2 to a total of 6 classes
 - 2 Citizenship classes
 - 2 General Education Development (GED) preparation classes
 - 2 Certified Nurses Assistant classes
 - 1 Bookkeeping/Account Clerk class
- ▶ Approximate funding request: \$227,000.00 for 2015/16 fiscal year
- ▶ Possible future course offerings:
 - Forklift Certification/Warehouse & Distribution
 - Truck Driving

Expansion & Collaboration

- ▶ Tentative plan is to collaborate with Newman/Crows Landing district to provide a West Side Adult Education Catalog that provides a comprehensive offering of basic education and vocational training programs to residents of western Stanislaus County.
- ▶ Newman/Crows landing tentatively plans to offer:
 - ESL
 - Microsoft Office certification
 - Welding classes.
